Arts For All History

Arts For All, Inc. became an expressed dream on January 18, 2006 when School of the Arts, a division of Presbyterian Outreach, closed.

Classes in piano, guitar, dance, and art at Arts For All started February 1, 2006. AFA offered these classes in donated spaces at two local churches. On July 19, 2006, Arts For All was granted non-profit status.

Today Arts For all, Inc. offers instruction in nine locations in the greater Omaha area (including Bellevue, Elkhorn, Papillion). Since its inception, AFA has served over 5,000 students.

Arts For All also provides private group instruction and special activities for parties and events, schools and organizations, as well as after-school programs at three public schools:

Classes

Nearly 60 professionals and teachers serve as instructors for classes at 6 metro Omaha locations, offered evenings Monday-Thursday and Saturday mornings. Our unique pricing structure offers most classes at \$6/session, with a sliding scale for those unable to pay. Many of our students qualify for free school lunch.
